

DAAD "Kigaru ni Austausch Presentation Coaching" (Spring 2024) – Detailed Schedule and Requirements

Apply by <u>April 28</u> to learn how to present in English like a professional with the guidance of bilingual expert Atsuko Kohata!

The coaching consists of five modules. Participation in all modules is required for completion. The program is held completely online.

1. **Workshop**: You get to know the other participants and your coach and get started on your presentation.

Date: Saturday, May 11, 16:00-19:00 JST / 9:00-12:00 CEST

What you need to do:

- Decide your presentation topic.
- Be ready to speak about your presentation topic in English for about 1 to 3 minutes.
- Participate in the workshop and introduce your topic to the other participants and the coach.
- 2. **First private coaching session**: You will prepare the first version of your presentation and define your individual challenges together with your coach.

<u>Deadline: Finish your first session by Friday, June 7.</u>

What you need to do:

- Schedule a session with the coach.
- Prepare a video of you giving your actual 15-25 min. presentation and send it to the coach at least one week before your session.
- Participate in the one-on-one session (1 hour) with your coach by June 7.
- Decide on the next steps together.
- 3. **Second private coaching session**: You will refine your presentation and work on your individual challenges together with your coach.

<u>Deadline: Finish your second session by Friday, June 28.</u>

What you need to do:

- Work on any areas that the coach has suggested in the previous session.
- Schedule a session with the coach.
- Send anything you agreed on with your coach one week before your session.
- Participate in the one-on-one session (1 hour) with your coach by June 28.
- Decide on the next steps together.

4. **Third private coaching session**: This will be the final lesson before you do your real presentation. *

Deadline: Finish your third session by Friday, July 19.

What you need to do:

- Work on any areas that the coach has suggested in the previous session.
- Schedule a session with the coach.
- Send anything you agreed on with your coach one week before your session.
- Participate in the one-on-one session (1 hour) with your coach by July 19.
- Decide on the next steps together.
- * If you or the coach notice that you need additional help after your practice presentation, you may be given the chance to participate in an additional one-on-one coaching session, subject to approval by DAAD.
- 5. **Final presentation**: You give your final presentation at a "Kigaru ni Austausch" event. <u>Deadline: Finish before Friday, November 29.</u>

What you need to do:

- Schedule a Kigaru ni Austausch event with DAAD at a date of your choosing (finish by November 29).
- Send the information for the flyer to DAAD at least two weeks before the event.
- Give your presentation to a live audience at Kigaru ni Austausch at your chosen date and answer the questions of the audience.
- If you wish to receive a certificate of completion, please contact DAAD after the event.
